
## TIEMPO LIBRE / BATHERS LEAVING THE ASTORIA POOL

Dimitra Kondylatou (b. 1987, Athens) lives and works in Athens. She studied Visual Arts at the Athens School of Fine Arts and the Dutch Art Institute in Arnhem. Her practice spans various media including video-making, editing, writing, and hosting. She is interested in the limits of art and its entanglements with tourism and everyday life.
